What This Privacy Policy Covers

* This policy covers how XMED Disposal treats personal information that XMED Disposal collects and receives, including information related to your past use of XMED Disposal products and services. Personal information is information about you that is personally identifiable like your name, address, email address, or phone number, and that is not otherwise publicly available.

Information Collection and Use

General

* XMED Disposal collects personal and organizational information when you register with XMED Disposal, when you use XMED Disposal products or services, when you visit XMED Disposal pages. XMED Disposal may combine information about you that we have with information we obtain from other government agencies.

* When you register we ask for information such as your name, email address, zip code, or other organizational information. Once you register with XMED Disposal and sign in to our services, you are not anonymous to us.

* XMED Disposal collects information about your transactions with us, including information about your use of services that we offer.

* XMED Disposal automatically receives and records information on our server logs from your browser, including your IP address, and the page you request.

* XMED Disposal uses information for the following general purposes: improve our services, contact you about problems, conduct research, and provide anonymous reporting for internal use.

Information Sharing and Disclosure

* XMED Disposal does not rent, sell, or share personal information about you or your organization with other people or nonaffiliated companies.

o We respond to subpoenas, court orders, or legal process, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims;

o We believe it is necessary to share information in order to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal activities, suspected fraud, situations involving potential threats to the physical safety of any person, violations of XMED Disposal's terms of use, or as otherwise required by law.

Your Ability to Edit and Delete Your Account Information and Preferences

General

* You can edit your XMED Disposal Account Information at any time.

* We reserve the right to send you certain communications relating to the XMED Disposal service, such as service announcements, administrative messages and the XMED Disposal Newsletter, that are considered part of your XMED Disposal account, without offering you the opportunity to opt-out of receiving them.

* You can delete your XMED Disposal account by visiting our Account Deletion page.

Confidentiality and Security

* We limit access to personal information about you to employees who we believe reasonably need to come into contact with that information to provide products or services to you or in order to do their jobs.

* We have physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with federal regulations to protect personal information about you.

Changes to this Privacy Policy

* XMED Disposal may update this policy. We will notify you about significant changes in the way we treat personal information by sending a notice to the primary email address specified in your XMED Disposal account or by placing a prominent notice on our site.
